Subject:- Report regarding Writ Petitions and availability of space for allotment in Initial Allotment.

It is submitted that process for inviting application for initial allotment was started on 26.05.2011 for allotment of 850 lawyers' chambers in Lawyers' Chambers Block.

It may be submitted that eight (08) slots (in double occupancy basis) are available for allotment (including the slot available for allotment due to disposal of Writ Petition of Ms. S.P. Sisodia) as per minutes dated 18.02.2014.

It may be submitted that the cases of applicants awaiting consideration were taken up in the meeting of Allotment Committee held on 18.02.2014 for allotment of 08 (eight) slots. On scrutiny of next 10 applications awaiting for allotment, it was found that most of them have not furnished proper proof of they being primarily practising at Patiala House Court, which was one of the essential conditions in the process of initial allotment.

It was resolved in the meeting that each of them be called upon to furnish such proof on or before 10.03.2014. Branch In-Charge, LCAC was directed to issue necessary communication. It may be submitted that necessary communication has been sent to them and most of them have submitted the documents.

It may be further submitted that one slot (in double occupancy basis) is now available for allotment in view of the withdrawal of CM No. 923/2013 by Sh. Sanjeev Sabharwal.

It may also be submitted that one slot (in double occupancy basis) is now available for allotment in view of surrender/cancellation of chamber No. 482 (earlier allotted to Sh. Omeswara Nand Sharma).

In view of the above, it may be submitted that ten (10) slots (in double

occupancy basis) are available for allotment.
